- 14. The final oral submissions shall not exceed sixty(60) minutes for the Appellants; sixty(60) minutes for the Respondents and ten(10) minutes for the reply of the Appellants
- 15. The hearing of this appeal will be held on **Tuesday the 11th day of February 2014 at 10.00 a.m.** at the Seat of the Court in Port-of-Spain, Trinidad and Tobago.
