THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF BARBADOS ON A STUDY VISIT TO THE CCJ AND THE JUDICIARY OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

CCJ, Port of Spain. A contingent from the Supreme Court of Barbados, including The Honourable Mr. Justice Marston Gibson, Chief Justice, and staff of the Registry, are in Port of Spain Trinidad for a study visit to the Caribbean Court of Justice (CCJ) and the Judiciary of Trinidad and Tobago.

This week at the CCJ, Chief Justice Gibson and his staff were involved in various training exercises to learn more about CCJ processes and case management information systems, among other things. The Chief Justice met with the Court President and Judges, and held discussions with the CCJ's Court Administration Leadership Team on the implementation of several judicial reform initiatives.

The Chief Justice also sat as a guest of the CCJ Judges on the bench for this week's court matters; *TCL v The Competition Commission* in Courtroom 1 on Wednesday 25th, and the matters of; *Dean C. Boyce v The Attorney General of Belize & The Minister of Public Utilities*, and *British Caribbean Bank Ltd v The Attorney General of Belize & The Minister of Public Utilities* held via video conferencing on Thursday 26th January 2012.

Chief Justice Gibson will be visiting the Judiciary of Trinidad and Tobago next week where he will be spending time in the Registry of the Supreme Court to observe their processes, and to meet with the Judges and Court Administrators to further the discussions on Judicial Reform.
